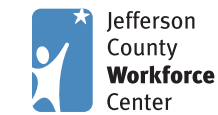
The Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) provides financial assistance, support services, and child care options to families seeking stability and self-sufficiency.

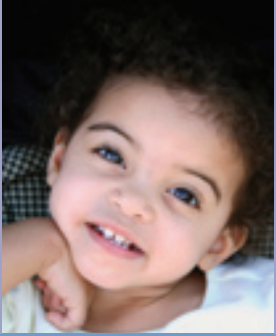


Serving the Tri-County Region

Can this help my family?

The cost of quality child care has grown enormously. If you have kids age 0 - 13, we may be able to pay a portion of those costs – directly to a qualified provider.

Who is eligible in Jefferson County?

Families enrolled and complying with a Colorado Works/TANF program, or...

Parents who are:

- working
- searching for work (up to 30 days)
- younger than 22 in a high school diploma program
- pursuing a post-secondary degree* or certificate (up to 24 months)
- enrolled in GED, ESL, or Adult Basic Education

These are basic guidelines; staff of the Child Care Assistance Program will determine eligibility, and re-confirm every six (6) months.

** not beyond your first Bachelor's*

What are my responsibilities?

After we confirm your eligibility, you're responsible for:

- maintaining eligibility as outlined
- a pre-set portion of the fees paid to your childcare provider
- verifying that your income falls within the following guidelines:

How do I get started?

- 1 Call Aspen Family Services at **303-604-1043** and dial the extension for *Jefferson County Intake*.
- 2 Aspen Family Services will ask for basic information, mail you an application, and help you schedule an Orientation Workshop. To preview a list of eligible providers, call **1-877-338-CARE (2273)** or visit qualistar.org.
- 3 Choose your provider, complete any requested paperwork, and bring this to your orientation.
