

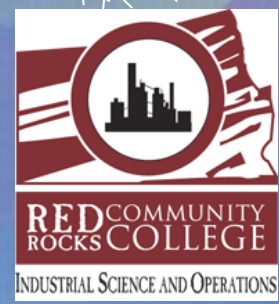
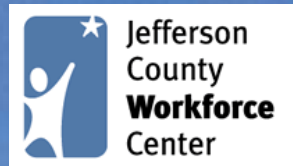

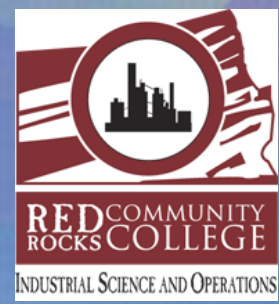

DESIGN & GOAL
