Tim Gomez is currently the Technology Coordinator and Computer Science instructor at Jefferson High School. Completing his second year at Jefferson, he has already made significant transitions within the school moving from mathematics instructor to his current technology role and is actively working on the redevelopment of the Jefferson High School Business Program.
